Self-Directed services -- Job seekers have access to resource library, computers, telephones, fax, copy machine, internet access, resume development, work skills exploration, networking skills workshops, interview techniques workshops;

Skill Assessment & Counseling Service -- one-to-one assistance by staff, assessment of skills and service needs, development of individual employment and career plan, career counseling, in-depth interviewing skills;

Training and Career Education -- occupational skills training, on-the-job training, job readiness training, adult education and literacy.
