The UNC Memory Disorders Program encompasses three interdisciplinary areas:

- 1) Clinical evaluation and comprehensive management of Alzheimer's disease and related dementias, including mild cognitive impairment (MCI), Lewy body dementia, and frontotemporal dementia/progressive aphasia;
- 2) To improve diagnosis and treatment, a research arm including investigator-initiated collaborative research projects in functional and structural brain imaging, biomedical informatics, and experimental therapeutic clinical trials in Alzheimer's disease and frontotemporal dementia, among others;
- Community educational outreach and physician training programs as part of the Carolina Alzheimer's Network in conjunction with Alzheimer's North Carolina.
